## **ALICE IN BUTLER COUNTY**



**ALICE** is an acronym for **A**sset **L**imited, **I**ncome **C**onstrained, **E**mployed – households that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living for the county. Households below the ALICE Threshold – ALICE households plus those in poverty – can't afford the essentials.

## The Cost of Basics Outpaces Wages

The Household Survival Budget (below) reflects the minimum cost to live and work in the modern economy and includes housing, child care, food, transportation, health care, a smart phone plan, and taxes. It does not include savings for emergencies or future goals like college or retirement. In 2022, household costs in every county in Ohio were well above the Federal Poverty Level of \$13,590 for a single adult and \$27,750 for a family of four.
