This locally funded program is supported by the Ohio Governor's office through branding and administrative support, but it is the generous donations across Butler County that allow this program to thrive.

As the Imagination Library fiscal agent for the county, Butler County United Way works closely with MidPointe Library Systems and Lane Public Libraries to ensure the program's success. Currently, over 10,000 Butler County children, age birth to 5, receive a free book each month.
