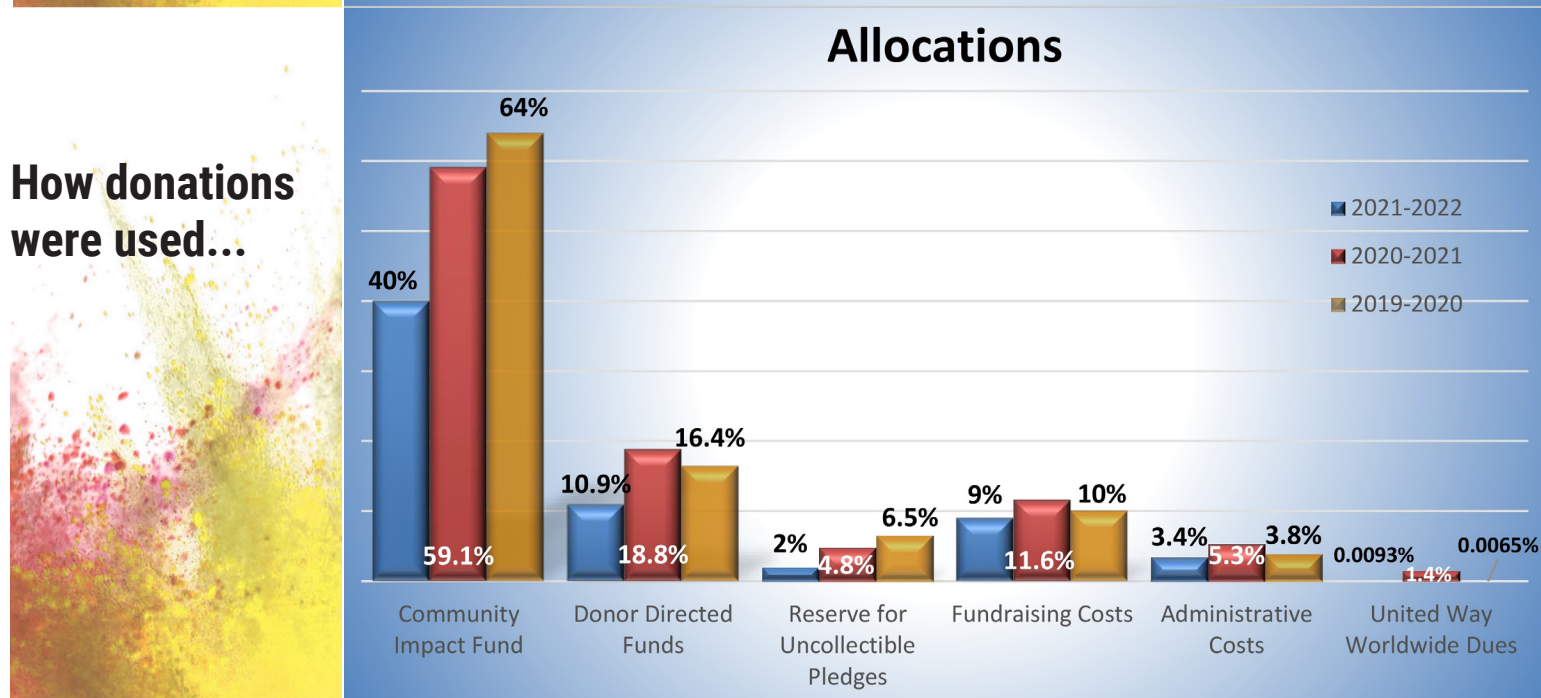

Kroger Plus Card

- If you are not a current Kroger Plus Cardholder, register online at krogercommunityrewards.com
- If you are a current Kroger Plus Cardholder, sign in to your digital account.
- Search for Butler County United Way or enter the code HJ861.
- You may view your Community Rewards contribution at any time by clicking on Community Rewards on the My Account screen.
- Swipe your registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to your registered Kroger Plus card when shopping for each purchase to count.

Gordon Food Service

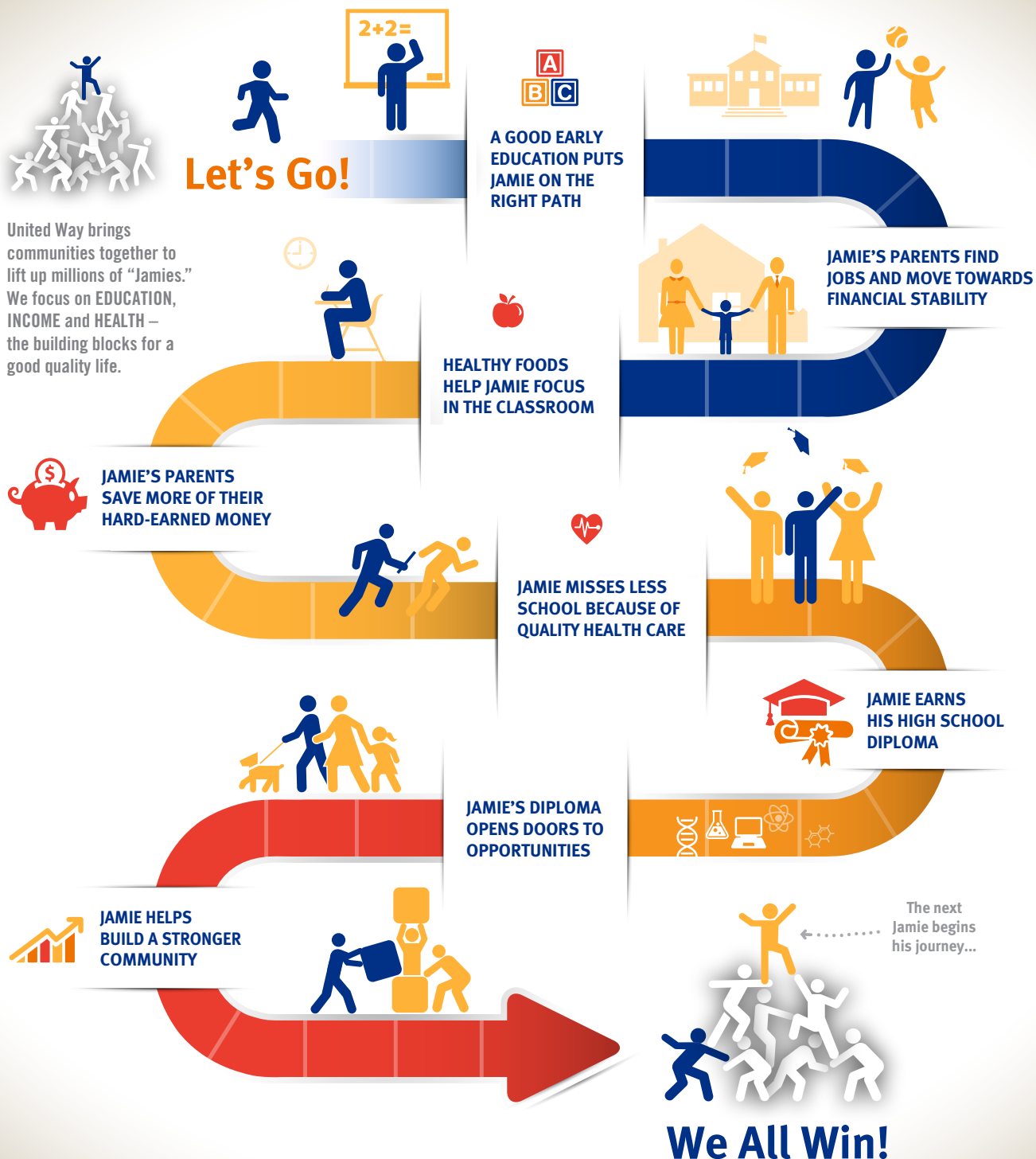
