All community members are invited to help in the effort by purchasing a case or more of water and either dropping it off at the event OR at M.A. Folkes Company anytime between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, throughout the entire month of March. As an alternative drop off, water may also be dropped off at Butler County United Way, 323 North Third Street, Hamilton, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday until March 31.

The donations gathered will be driven to Flint, Michigan, by Michael A. Folkes and his team members personally distributing the water donations to the economically disadvantaged communities. The goal is to fill five truckloads with bottled water or the equivalent of 75,000 cases of water to provide to the underserved populations of Flint.
