Butler County United Way highlights Community Impact with Breakfast, County-Wide Volunteer Event

(Butler County, OH) Butler County United Way is celebrating Volunteer Month on Thursday, April 17 with their Community Impact Breakfast and Macaroni Madness County-Wide Volunteer Event in collaboration with Community Partner, Shared Harvest Foodbank. The breakfast will include volunteer and donor recognition awards, while highlighting Butler County United Way's impact on its communities over the past year, through collaborations with more than 50 local Community Partners, and the generous support of volunteers, donors, and others.

Over the past year, thanks to the community's generous support, more than 6,719,658 pounds of food were distributed to Butler County residents uncertain of where their next meal was coming from. 7,921 people were provided emergency housing or assistance during crises. 2,626 kids and teenagers were able to learn life lessons, gain social skills, and saw higher grades after participating in funded after school and summer programs. "These are just a few examples of the impact we can have when we all work together, and we believe that should be celebrated," said Butler County United Way President and CEO, Pam Cottle.

The breakfast will begin promptly at 8 a.m. at Edgewood High School in Trenton, with the Macaroni Madness County-Wide Volunteer Event, in partnership with Shared Harvest Foodbank, immediately following. This special volunteer event will bring teams of volunteers together to portion packages of macaroni for distribution through Shared Harvest to families facing food insecurity in Butler County.
