CELEBRATE NATIONAL VOLUNTEER MONTH WITH OUR COMMUNITY IMPACT BREAKFAST




Butler County United Way is celebrating National Volunteer Month with the Community Impact Breakfast April 18 at Muhlhauser Barn.

COMMUNITY PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: AMERICAN RED CROSS GREATER CINCINNATI CHAPTER

Butler County United Way is proud to have the American Red Cross Greater Cincinnati Chapter as a strong partner, providing emergency needs for victims of disasters in our community. They successfully provide 24-7 emergency response for those in a time of need, including food, shelter, transportation, and health-related care utilizing dedicated community volunteers. In fact, they responded to 80 single and multi-family incidents and provided critical services to 99 families and 261 individuals in Butler County last year!

Part of their success is also preparedness response, such as the national American Red Cross Sound the Alarm initiative in which volunteers install life-saving smoke alarms and provide disaster education to those in need. Butler County United Way is excited to partner with the Greater Cincinnati Chapter in the local effort to install smoke alarms across Butler County on Thursday, April 18. In cooperation with local fire departments, volunteers will be taking to the streets in Hamilton, Middletown, Trenton, Fairfield, Oxford, and West Chester to install free smoke alarms, provide prevention education, and most importantly, save lives.
