
#### WELCOME OUR NEW BOARD OF TRUSTEES OFFICERS AND MEMBERS

#### COMMUNITY PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: Warren County Community Services

The Mission of Warren County Community Services, Inc. (WCCS) is to strengthen the fabric of our community by providing services and connecting people to resources necessary for realizing their full potential for a quality life. WCCS began serving Congregate Meals in Butler County in October of 2023. They were asked by Council on Aging (COA) of Southwest Ohio to take on the services of Congregate Dining in Middletown after a provider went out of business with little notice to COA. WCCS was eager to assist with this task to ensure the elderly population received the lunch meal they so deserved. With the support from Butler County United Way, during the last guarter of 2023, WCCS served over 14,000 meals to the elderly in Butler County.

WCCS currently serves over 170 Butler County senior residents at four different dining sites. By the end of September, they will be adding two additional sites at MidPointe Library in Monroe and in Trenton. They anticipate serving 50 additional seniors with those new locations.

WCCS is excited to continue to collaborate with Butler County United Way to fulfill the need for supplemental meals for seniors in Butler County.
