"Life Coach" Employee Retention Program

Butler County United Way recognizes that the solution to job retention involves many factors and teamwork. In collaboration with neighboring counties, The Workforce Investment Board of Butler, Clermont, and Warren counties surveyed local employers to identify the contributing factors of the job retention struggles faced by businesses. 'Personal/social barriers' and 'lack of soft skills' were the top two areas of concern. From this survey and the ensuing discussions, the concept of a workplace "Life Coach" was formed.
